Day 1: How would you define integrity? Job 27:5-6; Psalms 78:71-72; Proverbs 10:9, 11:3, 29:10.

Day 2: "Is it a lie if you're obviously joking?"

Day 3: Tell a friend that he or she can ask you about anything and promise that you will be honest with your answer. See how it goes.

Day 4: Do you find it easier to be honest with people who are close to you or people you don't know well? Why?

Day 5: How much time do you spend wondering what others think of you? In looking back on five decades in ministry, popular author Charles Swindoll...[said], "I would have cared less about what people thought or said. And I would have cared more about what Scripture said." How do you feel about Swindoll's comment?

Day 6: Where do you go first when you sin? How does Christ's love "compel us" to walk on with him (see 2 Corinthians 5:14-15, NIV)?

Day 7: Why is the road to integrity such a tough one? What disciplines should you engage in to become the person you know you should be six months from now? Write down your goals and show them to a friend.
